We are looking for friendly, energetic, responsible, honest, and hard-working individuals with a keen attention to detail to join our seasonal maintenance and grounds crew. Teamwork and a positive attitude are essential for this position.

This is a seasonal position roughly March through October. The work schedule may be flexible depending on weather and resort needs, with up to 40 hours per week.

Availability to work a flexible schedule, including weekends and holidays as well as a set morning or afternoon/evening shift is required for this position.

This is a great opportunity for people that work at Ski or Mountain Resorts in the winter and want a seasonal summer job!

Responsibilities:

- Raking, mowing, fertilizing, irrigation, trash collection, and general beautification and maintenance on a routine basis. The resort is roughly 20 acres and has approximately 1 mile of sandy beach that is raked and cleaned on a regular basis.
- Painting, cleaning exterior of cottages, cleaning public restrooms, pressure washing concrete pads and general clean-up of specified areas of the resort.

- Other skills that are desired are mechanical aptitude, plumbing, general construction, carpentry, vehicle repair and maintenance, organization skills, flower garden planning and maintenance, and/or previous landscaping experience.
- Maintaining a well-mannered, caring, and helpful attitude with guests and other staff members. Our guests are our number one priority!
- This job description does not list all the duties of this position. You may be instructed by management to perform other duties as assigned.

Physical Demands

- Requires the ability to lift and or/move objects weighing up to 100 pounds.
- Must be able to stand up to 8 hours per day. Length of time of tasks may vary.
- Constantly requires the ability to give and receive detailed information through verbal communication.
- Constantly requires verbally expressing or exchanging ideas of important instructions accurately, loudly, or quickly.
- Often requires walking or moving about to accomplish tasks.
- Occasionally requires standing and/or sitting for sustained periods of time.
- Occasionally requires ascending or descending stairs or ramps using feet and legs and/or hands and arms.
- Occasionally requires raising objects from a lower to a higher position or moving objects horizontally.
- Occasionally requires stooping which entails the use of the lower extremities and back muscles. Infrequently requires crouching.
- Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, and the ability to adjust focus.
